Kicking off this November after COP 23 in Bonn and continuing through the critically important 2018 mid-term elections, PCM will fill the streets from Miami to Minneapolis and Augusta to Anaheim with people demanding action and accountability on climate, jobs, and justice; we will organize and mobilize locally and nationally before and during the September Global Climate Action Summit; and in November, we'll hold our leaders accountable as only we can – with our vote.



We demand 100% commitment from our leaders to the fight for climate, jobs, and justice, including:

1 100% Commitment to Reducing Emissions and Creating a New Energy and Economic Future

We must drastically cut emissions that cause global warming by creating a New Energy and Economic Future with tens of millions of new jobs to transform energy infrastructure, strengthen and expand mass transit systems, improve energy efficiency in building stock, and transition to electric vehicles.

2 100% Equity for Everyone in the New Energy and Economic Future

Climate action – reducing pollution, building resilience, and supporting relief and recovery efforts – must lift up people of color, workers, and poor communities. Everyone, particularly those communities hardest hit by natural and economic disasters, should have the opportunity to benefit from the billions of public and private investments being made in the New Energy and Economic Future, not just the 1%. Everyone should have equal access, opportunity, and support to get a good job.

3 100% Union Wages that Support a Family

Every new job created to address the climate crisis and create a New Energy and Economic Future must be unionized or have the right to unionize without interference, and pay a family-sustaining wage. Jobs created should be targeted to low-income and unemployed people and people of color.

4 100% Pollution-Free Communities

The causes of climate change not only warm our planet but harm communities across the country. As we transition to a New Energy and Economic Future, we must fight to make sure that every person has clean air to breathe, clean water to drink, and can live in a community free from environmental degradation.

5 100% Protection for Workers

A just transition to a New Energy and Economic Future must ensure that workers, families, and their communities, which have been the backbone of the US economy for more than a century, are protected and cared for if job loss occurs.
